Hamburger. 汉堡。

That too.

You are very American. So, I will also say: French fries. 还有薯条。

How did you guess that?

It's easy. 他是很地道的美国人，所以很好猜。

Well, you guessed it right. I was thinking, today we can talk about ...

About "French Fries"?

Why not? Actually, why don't we talk about the "potato"?

Potato! 他说今天要来谈谈马铃薯。 You are serious. (Yes.)

The potato is great food.

马铃薯是个好食物。 I agree.

I know in French, the potato is called: earth apple.

在法语，马铃薯被叫做是：地里的苹果。

And in Finnish, they call it: earth pear.

而芬兰语，称它做：地里的梨子，是蛮像的。

How about in Chinese?

他问中文怎么称呼呢？ We called it: earth bean. 土豆。

Ha! A very big Earth Bean. Tu-Dou.

Right. Or, we say: foreign taro. 洋芋。

Yang-Yu. It's a foreign thing because it came from the West.

Yes. 称洋芋，因为是早期从西方进口的。 And, We also call it: Horse-Bell Yam.

What is that? Horse-Bell Yam.

That's right. Horse-Bell Yam 马铃薯 is potato.

Do you know what Wen-Jie?

What?

Nutrition of Potato 马铃薯营养高

Potatoes are nutritious and a great source of energy.

马铃薯很有营养, 也带来能量。

They are high in Vitamin C and Potassium.

马铃薯富含维他命 C 和 钾。

They are a good source of fiber.

它们也有丰富的纤维质。

They have less calories and fat than wheat.

比起麦子, 它的卡路里和油脂含量较少。

Potato skins are also good for you.

马铃薯皮对身体也很好。

It's best to eat potatoes with their skins.

吃马铃薯最好连皮都吃。

Coming up, is today's Everyday Dialogue.

A couple is making dinner together.

They plan to make a potato dish.

它们决定要作一道马铃薯料理。

Let's listen in to their conversation.

A: Honey, what are we cooking?

B: I'm thinking of making mashed potatoes.
