Naming Babies 为孩子取名

So, I am also Joanne Guo.

Culturally Speaking 话说文化

In the West, a married woman usually takes on the family name of her husband.

Right. But I notice Chinese given names may have one or two characters.

Sometimes it's repeat a character

Like the well-known Chinese musician Yo-Yo Ma.
