## Mountaineering Expedition 登山探险

The highest mountain in the world is Mount Everest.

In 1953, a ninth British expedition attempted to reach the summit of Everest.

The first pair came within 300 feet of the summit on May 26th.

Finally on May 29, 1953. New Zealander Hillary and Tibetan Norgay reached the highest point on the earth.
