### The Way We Talk 日常口语怎么说

The key phrase we're going to talk about today is: radio host.

今天的关键字, 广播主持人。

In United States, radio is a very important media to inform and to entertain.

美国的广播节目, 既是报导消息, 也是娱乐。

And we call the radio host, DJ or disc jockey.

主持人也叫做 DJ。

Why?

In early days, radio programs used to be playing music. They play record discs, and call the host disc jockey.

以前广播主要是做音乐节目, 因为是放唱盘的音乐, 因此主持人也叫 Disc Jockey。

Nowadays, radio is mostly talk show, with the host talking about different topics.

现今, 广播主要是谈话节目。主持人作访问, 谈论不同话题。

Sometime we use other terms like, radio announcer, radio presenter, or radio personality.

其他的称呼还包括了……

He or she can host a music program, a news program, a talk show or even a sports program.

可能主持的节目是音乐节目，新闻，谈话节目或是运动报导。

Being on the air is a fun job.

广播主持人的工作很有趣。

And these radio talk hosts can be very influential in people's views on politics.

谈话节目主持也很有影响力,能影响一般人的政治观点。

So there you have it: Radio host, radio announcer, radio personality, a disc jockey.

Mark, I guess it's quite an honor to be radio hosts.

Of course. I am honored to work with you each time we work together.

I have to say, you do have a wonderful voice.

- I: I understand your programs are available on I-tune, podcast as well as radio broadcast.

- I: Who is your favorite singer? Any favorite song?

- I: At the end, I'll play a piece of the song, so we can get a sense of what Dave likes.
