The Way We Talk 日常口语怎么说

Our key phrase today is: Taking Pictures.

今天的关键字是：taking picture

There's a saying: A picture is worth a thousand words.

有谚语说 A picture is worth a thousand words.

一张照片抵得过千句话。

Pictures can convey more effectively than words do.

表达事物，照片可以比说话来得更有效。

Another phrase is: picture perfect. That means, looking exactly right and correct.

另一句 picture perfect

意思是，看来很完美，恰恰好。

For example, someone would say: After doing all the work, finally, everything was picture perfect.

经过了那么多的努力后，所有事看来都很完美。

Now, here's another phrase: I get the picture.

You get the picture?

"I get the picture." means: I understand a situation.

Ah-ha! 这意思是：我懂了。

On the other hand, if someone is not getting the picture. We would say:

You are missing the big picture, meaning the whole picture.

如果是相反的，西方人会说。

You are missing the big picture.

That is to say: You miss the most important facts about a situation, and missed the impact of that on other things.

意思是：你没把握好重点，没看到整个图案相片，每了解到意思。

Let's review again. Taking Pictures. A picture is worth a thousand words. Picture perfect. I get the picture. The big picture, the whole picture.

Well, we all enjoy seeing pictures. And we all love to take pictures, right?

Interview: "about photography 谈摄影" - Joani Veenstra

Joani works in a Christian organization for 11 years

She grew up in Iowa, U.S.

She has 3 children.

I: Photography is your interest and hobby. Tell us about it.

J: * I have always loved photography. I ran a photography studio in Florida for 4 years.

* Moved to Chicago, stopped for a while, but decided to get back into it.

I: What kind of object do you shoot?

J: * I shoot just about everything...

* I like to take snapshots of people having fun,

* family photos, children photos, nature photographs

I: Do you work in a studio?

J: * No. I have a portable studio. I go to people. For equipment, I have a backdrop, lighting, stools, etc.

I: What made you interested in photography?

- J: * My dad likes to do photography. I would take his camera and shoot people's faces.
 * My dad gave me my first camera when I was in 4th grade.
- I: What kind of camera do you have now? What does it do?
 你拥有的照相机是如何的？
- J: * I have 3 cameras, one I put in my purse, just for point shoot, taking pictures of my kids in sport activities.
 * Another, Nikon D3000, a lightweight camera which takes crisp shots, and I am training my daughter to use it
 * The latest one is my "baby", which will do still pictures and video.
- I: What do you look for in order to take a good photo?

- J: * I look for variety of things. I like to shoot nature, and look at different angle at it. And people would say: I didn't see that.
 * Recently, I take photo in forest preserve. I took a picture of knotted branches with new greens growing on it. And people comment: "Life trying to take over Death"
- I: How does being a photographer change your life?

- J: * It allows me to see things differently
 * Even when my daughter and I shoot same things, but pictures are never the same. "I didn't see that or, I didn't think of that."
