Interview: a chat with Ardy about Being A Mom 妈妈经

- I: Tell us about your family. How old are your children. 你的家庭成员
- A: \* I have a husband and two children.

  - \* All of a sudden, that comes to a squeaky hault. My husband and I are trying to find our place now.

- A: \* My son got married on New Year's eve. It was a nice wedding, a big wedding party.
  - \* Yes, I did cry. I remembered him when he was little. Where did the time go?
  - \* We are happy for his decision. And I love his wife. (daughter-in-law)
  - \* My daughter has one more year, is studying Nursing, has a boyfriend now.
- I: Looking back, What was it like to raise them up? 抚养孩子长大的经验如何?
- A: \* It was a challenge. I tried to be with them all the time till they went to school.
  - \* Their manners (please, thanks & show appreciations.) were formed at home before going to school.
  - \* Some say: the first 5 years are the most important before they go to kindergarten.
- I: How about during school years? 当他们在学校求学时又如何?
- A: \* It's exciting. Once they started going to school and in full swing with things and friends, I did a lot of volunteering at school. I was always there as much as I could be

- \* Daughter was in ballet for 10 years, had a lot of practices. Son in the soccer with Park district. I drove them everywhere.
- I: What were some of the challenges you had to face? How did you overcome them?

  - \* I taught them the best I know how

- A: \* I think I did as best of a job as I could raising them. I have considerable joy knowing that they have good Christian mates, they know the Lord, they believe what we believe. This makes me very happy.
  - \* I pray for them every day. Let them know that I am with them as well as the Lord. They know if there's a problem, if they need help, they can call and I'm available for them.
