## The Way We Talk 日常口语

There are many idioms that have to do with vegetables.

有许多日常用语都和蔬菜有关。

Mark, teach us some.

First, "In a Pickle"

In a Pickle 字意,在腌黄瓜泡菜里。

When you are in a tight spot or facing a difficult situation, you are "In a Pickle".

这意思就是,你处境困难。

If someone says to you: you are "cool as cucumber". That's a compliment. 若有人对你说,你像黄瓜一样酷。

as cool as cucumber

这可是个赞扬。

That's a way of saying that you are very calm even facing a difficult situation.

这表示,你即使在困难情况中,还是非常镇定。

You want to know more?

Sure. Mark, I have heard of this phrase: Hot Potato.烫山芋。

What does it mean?

Well, When facing something that's difficult to deal with, we call that Hot Potato situation.

当遇到一些很难解决的事,就会描述那是个 Hot Potato。

There's another phrase: Couch Potato. This means a very lazy person who do not like to engage in a lot of physical activity.

Couch Potato 沙发椅上的土豆,意思就是很懒,整天坐著不动的人。 Huh, I am not a couch potato. No, you are not. All right. The last one is: "Like two peas in a pod". "Like two peas in a pod"

豆荚里的两颗豆子。

This is a way of saying that a person is very similar to someone else. 意思是两个不同的人非常相似。

So, If someone says to us: You are like two peas in a pod", that is to say we are very much alike.

Mark, that will never happen. You and I are completely different. Haha! Let's review the Idioms that contain vegetables:

## A Day In The Life Of 美人访谈

Interview: "Growing Vegetables 自家种菜" - with Anne

- I: I ate the tomatoes from your garden. They are sweet, and juicy. 你种的蕃茄又甜又好吃。
- A \* Now we have a lot of tomatoes. They are coming out in abundance. We also have varieties of peppers. 除了出产了许多蕃茄,我们也有许多的青椒,甜椒,辣椒。green pepper, sweet peppers, hot peppers.
- I: How did you start out growing a vegetable garden? 你怎么开始在家种菜的?
- A \* Fifteen years ago we moved to new home. It has a big property, and we decided to build a vegetables garden.
  - \* We went to store and bought vegetable plants, all kinds that we want to try.
  - \* It is a lot of work. But we thought it's a nice family project for my son and daughter to do as well.
- I: So, you have been growing vegetables for 15 years. –
- A \* Yes.

- I: What are some of the preparation you do before you plant? What is involved in the process?
  - 开垦菜园,有哪些准备工作?过程中需要注意什么?
- A \* A good soil is important. Tilting soil, make sure there's no weed or rocks.
  - \* The plants need certain amount of space to grow, so we have to measure out how many inches apart.
  - \* After planting them, we need to fertilize them in the beginning, and making sure soil is not too dry. Always water them.
  - \* We use natural compost which adds nutrient to make sure they grow.
- I: What kind of food do you make from the produce you grow? 你用所出产的做出什么菜?
- A \* We use tomatoes in the salad, or eat them plain. We stew tomatoes and freeze them, as well as peppers, onions, carrots.
  - \* My husband likes broccolis and he usually eats it all.
- I: You have to "Get Your Hands Dirty" in this garden business. How do you think about it?

- A \* I don't mind, but my daughter doesn't like it.
  - \* It's very worthwhile. It's worthy. You know what you do is a good cost.
- I: In order to have harvest, one needs to get hands dirty and put in work.

I grow bitter melons 我种苦瓜。

It's so bitter, I don't think you would want to try it.

Wen-Jie, I'll bet you get a lot of personal satisfaction from growing your own vegetables.

Yes! I love to see things grow.

看到种植的东西成长总让我感到满足兴奋。

And not only in my garden, I love to see children and young people grow in maturity.

And I love to see Christian folks grow in their faith and their knowledge of Jesus Christ.
