One key word today is: Receive

This can be: receiving something or receiving somebody.

可以是接受什么东西,或接待某人。

Like, We received many emails from listeners.

我们收到听友许多电邮。

She has been received into the English Club.

她被接受加入了英语社团。

The noun of receive is, "Reception". It's the action of receiving or being received.

Reception 这个名词,意思也是:接待接纳,欢迎会。

For example, we can say, Let's have a reception.

让我们开个欢迎会。Let's have a reception.

Or. He receives a warm reception.

他得到热诚的欢迎。receives a warm reception.

There are other phrases relating to the word: reception.

其他相关的字还有:

Like: Reception desk (服务台), Reception room (客厅)

And the person who is working at the reception desk is called a "receptionist"-reception, plus i-s-t receptionist.

A receptionist can answer phones, makes appointment, receives guests, and many more.

Interview: "My work as a receptionist 身为接待员" - with Anne

- I: You always have a wonderful smile on your face.
- I: How did you come to work here as a receptionist? 你是如何成为一个接待员的?
- A: * Years ago, I was working at a bank. There was a learning session, someone says: Anne, you have a wonderful voice. You can be a good receptionist. And now I am working as one.
- I: Phone etiquette and phone presence is important as a receptionist.
- I: What is your work? What do you do? 你的工作包含了哪些层面?
- A: * My main job as a receptionist is to answer the phone promptly, do very best with each call, make sure it gets to the person it needs, or help with what they're calling about.
- I: You are multi-tasking many work. 从事多重的工作。
- A: * Yes. My work also involves administration work, reporting, computer work, doing deposits.
- I: You need to talk and interact with people, right? 工作上需要和人见面交谈沟通。
- A: * There are people come to the door everyday for various reason. I'm the first person they talk to. So, it's important to have positive attitude.
- I: What give you joy in your work? What makes it difficult for you? 在工作上,什么带给你快乐和难处?
- A: * I enjoy the people I work with, not only the people in the office, but also people on the phone.
 - * They share about their lives, stories, histories. Those interesting things that otherwise I'll miss if I don't work here.
 - * The difficult thing is, occasionally, I get call from people who are not happy or not going to be happy no matter how much we try to help them.

I: How do you see your role and your work in light of the whole organization and ministry?

But instead, should build the relationships on truths that are of greater importance.
