The Way We Talk 日常口语

Our key word today is: Music

今天的关键字是：Music 音乐。

We would say: It's "Music to my ears". (It's Music to my ears.) This means something or some information pleases me very much.

这个谚语的含义是，耳朵所听到的事情，让我很开心。

Here's another phrase "Set something to music" (Set something to music)

This means to write music to go with the words.

意思是，为文字或诗谱曲。

The adjective for music is the word "Musical".

形容词是 musical 有音乐才华的，音乐细胞的。

We would say, She is very musical, She has a musical voice.

她非常喜爱音乐，她的声音很动听。

When describing a person who makes music by playing or conducting,

当描述一个人会弹会演奏或指挥。

we call him or her, a musician.

这人是个音乐家 musician。

That's the word: music, with i-a-n at the end.

Let's have a review. Music, It's Music to my ears, Set something to music, Musical, and Musician.

Coming up next, We have a musician in our midst. Our coworker Eleanor.

紧接著，我们有个音乐家 Eleanor 在我们当中。

Eleanor can sing. She plays instruments. She is very musical.

Eleanor 会唱歌，又会弹乐器。她很有音乐才华。

Interview: "Love for Music 爱音乐" - Eleanor

I: How did you develop your love and appreciation for music?

- E: *
- I love music as a child. My father instilled that in my heart since young and I remembered 5,6 years old, singing with my father while walking.
 - * Piano is important in the house, and I learned to play when I was 7. My older sister plays very well. I had piano lessons until I graduated from high school.
 - * After getting married and had children, I learned to play organ. I played organ in the church.

I: How has Music affected you in your personal life?

- I used to be singing with my children on long car trips. They learned many songs, and still remember them.
 - * Music is for both happy and sad times. In my family, wedding and funerals, music is a big part.
 - * I have been a widow for 20 years. On my husband's funeral, the singing and organ playing was so moving and meaningful to me.
 - * Music can express what's in our soul, it speaks a special language.

I: Do you have a song running through your head now? Can you share with us?

- Hymn "My Jesus, I Love Thee" was sung in my husband's funeral.
 - * The last verse says:
"In mansions of glory and endless delight. I'll ever adore thee in heaven so bright. I'll sing with the glittering crown on my brow. If ever I loved thee, my Jesus, 'tis now."

Eleanor shared about how music is meaningful and comforting to her.
