Communicate and Communication

Communicate, this word is a verb

(Communicate 是动词，意思是传播，传达)

We say, communicate one's ideas, or feelings to others.

(有话说，把一个人的想法，感受传达给他人。 communicate one's ideas,

feelings to others.)
Communication, this word is a noun.
Communication 是名词。
We say, prevent communication or restore communication.
有话说, 阻断联系 prevent communication 或恢复联系 restore communication

Mark, we communicate by radio with our listeners.
That's right.

And listeners can communicate with us by letter or e-mail.

How about now?
Now, I call them every week. 现在我则每星期和他们通电话。
Making a phone call is very direct and convenient.
是阿, 打电话的确很直接很方便。 How about you, Mark? How do I keep in touch with family members? 你又是怎样和家人保持联络呢?
Mine is the best way. We visit each other.
马可说他的方法最好, 就是彼此探望。 How nice.
My sisters and I all live not too far from each other.
他和几位姊姊都住得很近。 That's great. My brothers and I live very far from each other. 我的兄弟和我可是离了十万八千里。
How do you keep in touch then?
We email each other. 我都用电邮和他们联系的。
Email. That's what I use to contact my friends.
电邮, 的确是和朋友沟通的好管道。
